



ScreenEx® is a retractable screen system which is almost invisible when not in use. ScreenEx disappearing screens end fighting with sliding screens and they can cover openings that many consider impossible to screen - French doors and garages, to name two. Best of all is how easy they are to install. It takes about 20 minutes and as few as 8 screws. The only requirement is the screens must be installed level and square! That is it!

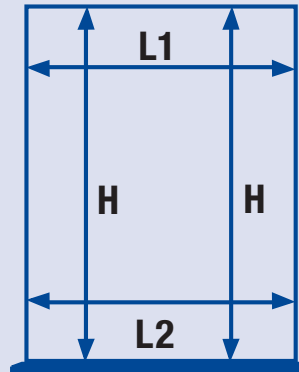
ScreenEx is made in two operating styles, pull down or side pull and fit up to a 12 foot tall openings. Tracks and cassette have a slim profile and come in white, almond and brown. When not needed, the screen retracts into the low profile cassette leaving a clear view through your door or window. The screen slides along track and secures in place. There isn't a rigid frame to get bent and hamper sliding. If accidentally walked into, the screen gives with the pressure then slides back into place without damage.

Mounting positions are also numerous. You choose what position best suits your needs. ScreenEx retracting screens can be installed on exterior or interior of a structure, inside the frame or on the outside of the frame. Side pull screens can be installed for either left or right side pulling and you can make that decision when you are installing.

You can paint tracks and cassette to match window or door trim color. Or use molding to conceal the cassette and tracks. We can also provide screen kits with sunscreen material to block UV light at an additional cost.

HOW-TO-MEASURE



Inside/Recessed Mount:
Measure both left and right sides and top and bottom. Your dimension for order is the smallest height and smallest length.

Outside/Surface Mount:
Measure both left and right sides and top and bottom. Add 3 inches to length and 3 inches to height.

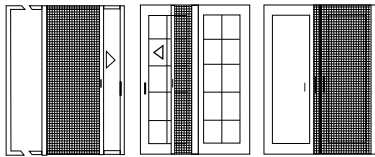

This style is perfect for low traffic entries and large windows. Create a new living space using ScreenEx pull downs to enclose a deck with minimal framing.

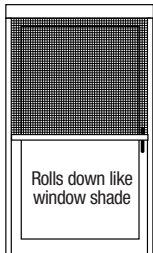
The pull down version has no track on the bottom making it the perfect solution where wheelchair access is needed.

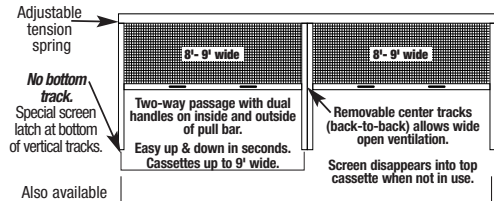
ScreenEx III Extra Wide Screen Kits

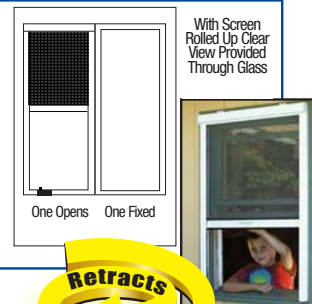

You will use shortest measurement of your horizontal measurements and the shortest of your vertical measurements for inset mounting. Add 3 inches minimum to your shortest measurement for mounting outside the frame.

Kits for windows and doors - dozens of pre-cut sizes that you cut down when installing.

Pull down or side pull - choose operating style that best suits your need.

Interior or exterior installation - install on outside or inside the home depending on needs. (Use trim or molding to cover housing and tracks for a fully finished look.)

Versatile - our D.I.Y. Screen Kits cover the expected - windows, doors, sliding doors. And they screen what some consider impossible ... French doors, garage doors and other openings up to 12 feet tall.

No rigid frames - slides easily in secured tracks. Gives with pressure then retracts back into place.
